Alain Schoepfer is a board-certified adult gastroenterologist. He leads the Outpatient clinics and the Inflammatory Bowel Disease team at the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vaudois in Lausanne, Switzerland. He is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Medicine and Biology of University of Lausanne, Switzerland. Dr Schoepfer leads the SNEGID, the Swiss Network of Eosinophilic Gastrointestinal Diseases and the SEECS, the Swiss Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE) Cohort study which currently follows >650 adults with EoE. He performed a postdoctoral fellowship at the Farncombe Family Institute of Digestive Health Research at McMaster University, Hamilton, ON, Canada. His research in EoE is focused on standardizing assessment of disease activity on the level of patient reported outcomes, quality of life, endoscopic and histologic activity. Together with an international group of collaborators, he developed and validated the EEsAl PRO instrument, a score to assess EoE-related symptoms. The EEsAl PRO score has been used in numerous randomized clinical trials. Dr Schoepfer was EUREOS president from 2015 to 2017. He has published more than 250 papers in the field of EoE and inflammatory bowel disease.
